

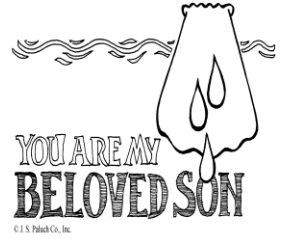

**BISHOP RAYMOND W. LESSARD** . . . Bishop Raymond Lessard, who served as Bishop of Savannah for 22 years, died Sunday January 3, at his home at St. Vincent de Paul Seminary in Boynton Beach, Florida, surrounded by priests and seminarians of the seminary. Bishop Lessard served as the 12<sup>th</sup> Bishop of Savannah from 1973 to 1995. He was 85. Visitation will be held in Savannah at the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. An Evening Prayer Service including the Office for the Dead will be held at 7 p.m. The Mass of the Resurrection will be celebrated at 12 noon on Tuesday, January 12 at the Cathedral. Bishop Hartmayer will be main celebrant; Bishop Emeritus J. Kevin Boland will be homilist. He will be buried in the Diocesan Priests' section in the Catholic Cemetery in Savannah. Please pray for the happy repose of his soul.
